Athenaeum Club Dress Code: Annex A

The Club requires dress standards that reflect the gracious ambience of the clubhouse.

Gentlemen

Refined business attire. Either suit or tailored sports jacket, tailored trousers and collared shirt. Ties are preferred but optional. Denim, polo tops, sports attire, or distressed apparel are not permitted. The only exception is attendance at the gym, or resident members/guests entering or exiting the Club. Satchels and bags must be left in the cloak room.

Footwear should be of a conservative style matching the required business attire. Sports shoes and sneakers, sandals and boat shoes are not permitted outside of the gym or pool areas. Orthopaedic shoes of a conservative style and colour are permitted.

Jackets may be removed at the discretion of the conveners of private functions, but only within the rooms such functions are held in.

Removal of jackets is acceptable on the rooftop, at breakfast, and during play in the Billiards Room; however, jackets must be worn when departing these areas at any time and in other areas of the Club as per the dress code.

Ladies

A refined dress standard is required to reflect both the formality of the Club and a sense of occasion.

Denim, sports attire, distressed apparel, sports shoes and sneakers are not permitted, with the exception of the arrival and departure of resident guests.

Footwear should be conservative matching the above dress standard.

Guests

These dress standards apply to all guests attending Club events and dining outlets. Gentlemen guests under twelve years of age are not required to wear a jacket at family events.

Guests using the Club's accommodation may exit and enter the Club wearing casual attire, but not visit the public rooms while dressed casually.

Private Functions

At all times members and guests are bound by the Club's dress code, with the exception of weekend events where dress code requirements may be varied by arrangement with management.

Gym Users

A member using the gymnasium may directly enter and exit via the front entrance in sporting attire. Access to the Basement area can also be via the back door located in Chester Lane. Members must change into appropriate attire to access all other areas of the Club, no matter how brief.

National Dress

Exceptions to these dress codes can be made for members or guests wishing to wear national dress to a Club event with prior discussion with the General Manager.
